Host Services

Host committee volunteers can be found throughout the convention facilities. Monitors will provide members with directions. Hospitality volunteers will staff the information tables and Hospitality Rooms. Greeters will greet members as they come through the doors.

Registration

Registration volunteers staff the registration tables and ensure that those who have pre-registered and those who choose to register at the convention receive the proper materials, tickets and information. Note: Pre-conventions cash register training and a clean time requirement are required for all cashiers.

Program

Program committee volunteers staff the Speaker-Secretary Check-In Table, monitor meetings for attendance and to ensure safety, and provide all services necessary to make the meetings the wonderful experience NCCNA convention attendees have come to expect.

Merchandise

Merchandise room volunteers help to maintain a consistent supply of displayed merchandise, answer questions regarding sizes and colors available, and work at the cashier stations selling merchandise. Note: Pre-conventions cash register training and a clean time requirement are required for all cashiers.
